

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS STATUTE 75-1013.1 TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION SHALL NOT INCLUDE IN A DRIVER'S TRAFFIC VIOLATION REPORT ANY SPEEDING CONVICTIONS WHERE THE SPEED WAS LESS THAN SEVENTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 276 of 1975, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statute 75-1013.1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. All courts in this State now required by law to furnish records of convictions of all motor vehicle violations to the Office of Driver Services of the Department of Finance and Administration shall continue to furnish said records but in compiling reports of convictions of traffic violations, the Office of Driver Services shall not include in the traffic violation report of any individual any conviction for the offense of speeding if the conviction is based on speeding upon a public highway in excess of fifty-five (55) miles per hour speed limit as established pursuant to Public Law 93-239 of January 2, 1974, but less than seventy-five (75) miles per hour. The Office of Driver Services shall include in the traffic violation report of any person holding a chauffeur's license any conviction for the offense of speeding in excess of the fifty-five (55) miles per hour speed limit as established pursuant to Public Law 93-239 of January 2, 1974, to the employer of such person, and shall furnish the complete driver history record of such person pursuant to a written authorization as provided in Act 465 of 1977 to the employer of the person holding a chauffeur's license."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
