"AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 846 OF 1983 TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARY AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCE OF THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS OF CRAIGHEAD COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 846 of 1983 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. The Prosecuting Attorney of the Second Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit may appoint one (1) or more deputy prosecuting attorneys for the Western District of Craighead County at a combined salary not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) perannum plus a combined contingent expense allowance not to exceed eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) per annum; and one (1) deputy prosecuting attorney at a salary not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum plus a contingent expense allowance not to exceed seventy-five hundred dollars (\$7,500) per annum."

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Act 372 of 1979, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The salary of the Deputy Prosecuting Attorney in Cross County in the First Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit shall be not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) annually nor more than twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$27,000) annually payable in equal monthly installments from the County General Fund of Cross County. In addition to the salary prescribed by this act, the Deputy Prosecuting Attorney shall be entitled to expense allowances as provided by the quorum court of Cross County."

SECTION 3. Act 805 of 1983 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
