"AN ACT TO CONVERT THE CHANCERY JUDGESHIP AND THE CIRCUIT JUDGESHIP OF THE EIGHTH DISTRICT TO CIRCUIT-CHANCERY JUDGESHIPS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

- SECTION 1. (a) Effective January 1, 1991 the circuit judgeship in the Eighth Judicial Circuit provided for in Arkansas Code 16-13-1603(a) shall be converted to a circuit-chancery judgeship. The qualified electors of the Eighth Judicial Circuit shall at the general election of 1990 and every four (4) years thereafter elect a circuit-chancery judge in lieu of the circuit judge provided for in Arkansas Code 16-13-1603(a).
- (b) Effective January 1, 1991 the chancery judgeship in the Eighth Judicial Circuit provided for in Arkansas Code 16-13-1603(a) shall be converted to a circuit-chancery judgeship. The qualified electors of the Eighth Judicial Circuit shall at the general election of 1990 and every four (4) years thereafter elect a circuit-chancery judge in lieu of the chancery judge provided for in Arkansas Code 16-13-1603(a).
- SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
