"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES DIVISION FOR THE BIENNIAL
PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1991; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - REVENUE SERVICES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division for the 1989-91 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - REVENUE SERVICES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division for the 1989-91 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two hundred (200) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATIONS - DATA PROCESSING. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for the purchase of data processing of the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division for the biennial period ending June

SECTION 8. APPROPRIATIONS - POSTAGE EXPENSES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for postage expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1991, the following:

SECTION 9. CARRY FORWARD - REVENUE. The unexpended balances in the appropriations provided in Item (02) of Section 3 and in Item (01) of Section 7 remaining on June 30, 1990, may be carried forward and used for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991.

SECTION 10. LINE ITEM TRANSFERS. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to transfer appropriation from the Maintenance and General Operation line item appropriation, Operating Expense Classification, as provided in Item (04)(A) of Section 3 to the Special Printing line item appropriation as provided in Item (05) of Section 3 herein in order to provide for purchase of sufficient Special Printing items for the Revenue Division. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall immediately report any such transfers to the Arkansas Legislative Council. Such report shall contain the amounts transferred and the reasons for same.

SECTION 11. POSTAGE - REVENUE. Revenue Services shall have the authority to make expenditures for postage from Appropriations - Revenue Services, in Section 3 of this Act, or Appropriations - Postage Expense, in Section 8 of this Act or Appropriations - Revenue Services - Safety Responsibility, in Section 6 of this Act.

SECTION 12. Extra Help positions authorized herein are specifically exempt from limitation of hours, either by act or regulation. Provided, however, when a temporary or part-time employee is employed by the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services for a period of time exceeding seven (7) months, a report of such shall be filed with the Arkansas Legislative Council.

SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 15. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. Act 483 of 1989 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1989 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1989 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1989.
