## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-54-107 CONCERNING THE OFFENSE OF COMPOUNDING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS
```

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-54-107 is amended to read as follows: "5-54-107. Compounding.
(a) A person commits the offense of compounding if he:
(1) Solicits, accepts, or agrees to accept any pecuniary benefit as consideration for refraining from reporting to law enforcement authorities the commission or suspected commission of any offense or information relating to an offense; or
(2) Offers, confers, or agrees to confer a benefit, the receipt of which is prohibited by this section.
(b) Compounding is a:
(1) Class B felony if the offense concealed is a Class Y felony;
(2) Class C felony if the offense concealed is a Class A felony;
(3) Class D felony if the offense concealed is a Class B, C, D, or unclassified felony;
(4) Class B misdemeanor if the offense concealed is a misdemeanor of any class."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
