SENATE BILL 582

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS ADULT PROBATION
10 COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
16 Arkansas Adult Probation Commission for the 1991-93 biennium, the following
17 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
18 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
19 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
20 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
21 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
22 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
25 successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Adult Probation Commission for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four (4) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Adult Probation Commission, to be payable from the Arkansas Adult Probation Commission Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Adult Probation Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

5 SECTION 4. TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon seeking and receiving approval

6 from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Director of the Arkansas Adult

7 Probation Commission is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line

8 item authorized in Section 3 of this Act to any other line item authorized in

9 Section 3 of this Act.

10

11 SECTION 5. The appropriations authorized for "Financial Aid" funds

12 herein are to be used by the Arkansas Adult Probation Commission for financial

13 assistance including direct purchases of equipment/supplies to Circuit Courts

14 that conform to the standards and policies promulgated by the Commission, to

15 achieve the purposes stated in Arkansas Code 12-48-106, and shall not be

16 subject to appropriation by nor be subject to the control of any Quorum Court.

17 Nothing in this Section is to be construed as to limit the authority of any

18 Quorum Court to appropriate county funds.

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20 SECTION 6. Upon seeking and receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal

21 Officer of the State, the Director of the Arkansas Adult Probation Commission

22 is authorized to use funds appropriated in the "Financial Aid" line item in

23 Section 3 of this Act to support the development of special projects or to

24 match any federal or private grants awarded to the Commission.

26 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

27 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

29 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control

32 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the

33 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 3 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
 4 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9
 10 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 11 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 12 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13
 14 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
 15 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
 16 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
 17 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
 18 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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 20 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
 21 with this Act are hereby repealed.

22
 23 SECTION 12. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Arkansas Adult Probation Commission
 24 shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per
 25 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health
 26 Insurance Program.

27
 28 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
 29 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
 30 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
 31 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
 32 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
 33 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
 34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
 35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

1 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
2 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
3 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
