8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 26-75-606(a)(1) CONCERNING
9 THE AUTHORITY OF A CITY ADVERTISING AND PROMOTION
10 COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-75-606(a)(1) is amended to read as follows:

16 "(1) All funds credited to the city advertising and promotion fund
17 pursuant to this subchapter shall be used for advertising and promoting the
18 city and its environs or for the construction, reconstruction, extension,
19 equipment, improvement, maintenance, repair, and operation of a convention
20 center in the city, and facilities necessary for, supporting, or otherwise
21 pertaining to, a convention center, or for the payment of the principal of,
22 interest on, and fees and expenses in connection with, bonds as provided in
23 this subchapter in the manner as shall be determined by the city advertising
24 and promotion commission. The city advertising and promotion commission may
25 engage such personnel and agencies and incur such administrative costs that it
26 deems necessary to conduct its business."

27
28 SECTION 2. It is the intent of this act to affirm the authority of city
29 advertising and promotion commissions over the use of the city advertising and
30 promotion commission funds for administrative and promotional purposes.

31
32 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
33 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
34 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.
