**A BILL ACT 162 OF 1991**  
**SENATE BILL 2**

**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CODE TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM  
9 EXAMINATION FEES FOR REGISTERED NURSES AND PRACTICAL  
10 NURSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13

14 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-86-301(c)(1) is hereby amended to read as  
15 follows:

16 "(c)(1) Fees. The applicant for a license to practice as a registered  
17 nurse, issued pursuant to examination, shall pay a fee not to exceed thirty  
18 dollars (\$30.00) for the original license, a fee not to exceed one hundred  
19 twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) for the original examination, and a fee not to  
20 exceed one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) for any subsequent  
21 reexamination."

23 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-86-304(c)(1) is hereby amended to read as  
24 follows:

25 "(c)(1) Fees. The applicant for a license to practice as a licensed  
26 practical nurse issued pursuant to examination shall pay a fee not to exceed  
27 thirty dollars (\$30.00) for the original license issued pursuant to  
28 examination, a fee not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the  
29 original examination, and a fee not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00)  
30 for any subsequent reexamination."

31

32 SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35

36 SECTION 4. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 Act are declared to be severable.

5

6 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are  
7 hereby repealed.
