Arkansas Code 24-8-215(c) is amended to read as follows: 15 "(c)(1) Any judge or justice who becomes seventy (70) years of age during a term of office to which he has been elected may complete the term without forfeiting his rights to retirement benefits under this section. (2) Any judge or justice who is not eligible to retire at age 18 19 seventy (70) may continue to serve as judge until the completion of the term 20 of office in which he receives sufficient credited service to retire without 21 losing his retirement benefits. The judge or justice shall lose all 22 retirement benefits if he serves beyond the end of the term needed to get 23 sufficient credited service to retire." (3) Otherwise, judges or justices must retire by their seventieth 2.4 25 birthday or lose their retirement benefits. However, any active judge or 26 justice who was serving prior to July 1, 1965, may continue to serve until any 27 age and shall, upon retirement, be eliqible to receive retirement benefits. 28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 29 30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 32 33 If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
