**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-403(b) LIMITING THE  
9 TIME PERIOD DURING WHICH THE COUNTY CLERK MUST MAIL  
10 ABSENTEE BALLOTS TO AN ADDRESS WITHOUT AN ADDITIONAL  
11 REQUEST BY THE VOTER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-403(b) is amended to read as follows:

16 "(b) Any person eligible to vote by absentee ballot may request the  
17 county clerk to mail to an address within the continental United States an  
18 application for an absentee ballot for each election thereafter. The request  
19 shall remain in effect for one year unless revoked by the voter, and the  
20 county clerk shall thereafter automatically mail, no later than thirty (30)  
21 days prior to each election, an application for an absentee ballot."

23 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature  
24 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
25 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

27 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to  
28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
29 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without  
30 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
31 Act are declared to be severable.

33 SECTION 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this Act are  
34 hereby repealed.
