| 18 | SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. §14-236-106(c) is hereby amended to read as |
| 19 | follows: |
| 20 | "(c) Any person, firm, corporation, or association, with the exception |
| 21 | of the homeowner, who violates any of the provisions of this chapter or any |
| 22 | rules and regulations promulgated under the authority of this chapter shall, |
| 23 | upon conviction, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a |
| 24 | fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than five hundred |
| 25 | dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment not exceeding one (1) month, or both." |

| 27 | SECTION 2. Ark. Code Ann. 14-236-116 is hereby amended to read as |
| 28 | follows: |
| 29 | "14-236-116. Permit and registration fees - Annual training course. |
| 30 | (a) A fee of thirty dollars ($\$30.00$) shall be levied for the review of |
| 31 | individual sewage disposal permit applications . However, it shall not be |
| 32 | necessary to pay an additional fee to obtain a permit to repair an individual |
| 33 | sewage disposal system or alternate and experimental system installed under a |
| 34 | permit for which a fee has been paid under the provisions of this chapter. |
| 35 | (b) A fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be levied annually for the |

36 registration of installers.

1 (c) A fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) shall be levied annually for 2 the registration of septic tank manufacturers.

- 3 (d) A designated representative must attend at least one (1) annual
- 4 training course provided by the Department of Health and pay a fifty dollar
- 5 (\$50.00) fee annually to maintain certification.
- 6 (e) The fee for the issuance of a review certificate under the
- 7 provisions of this chapter to the person developing a subdivision shall be a
- 8 minimum of thirty dollars (\$30.00) for one (1) lot and five dollars (\$5.00)
- 9 for each following lot, with a maximum of five hundred dollars (\$500).
- 10 (f) Permit and regulation fees collected under this chapter shall be
- 11 deposited in the State Treasury as follows:
- 12 (1) Five dollars (\$5.00) of each permit fee collected for permits
- 13 issued under subsection (a) of this section shall be credited to a special
- 14 fund to be known as the 'Individual Sewage Disposal Systems Improvement Fund',
- 15 which is established on the books of the State Treasurer, with such moneys to
- 16 be used by the Division of Sanitarian Services of the Department of Health
- 17 for, and in the manner recommended by the Advisory Committee on Individual
- 18 Sewage Disposal Systems, the implementation of the utilization and application
- 19 of alternate and experimental individual sewage disposal systems, as set forth
- 20 in this chapter.
- 21 (2) The remainder of the fees collected for permits issued under
- 22 the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, and all of the net fees
- 23 collected under the provisions of 14-236-112(c) and subdivisions (b) and (e)
- 24 of this section shall be credited to the Public Health Fund, and the moneys
- 25 shall be used only for the operation of the Division of Sanitarian Services of
- 26 the Department of Health; and
- 27 (3) Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented
- 28 by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the disbursing officer for the
- 29 Department of Health is hereby authorized to transfer all unexpended funds
- 30 relative to the funds outlined in subdivision (f)(2) of this section that
- 31 pertain to fees collected, as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 32 State, to be carried forward and made available for expenditures for the same
- 33 purpose for any following fiscal year; and
- (g) (1) Permits issued under subsections (b), (c) and (d) of this
- 35 section shall be nontransferable and shall be renewed annually.

| 13 | Act are declared to be severable. |
