13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15	SECTION 1. Reports shall be made to the Arkansas Department of Health
16	in such form and manner as may be required by the Department for all persons
17	who have been determined to have Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS) or
18	who have tested positive for the presence of Human Immunodeficiency Virus
19	(HIV) antigen or antibodies. Reporting is required by the following persons:
20	Physicians;
21	Hospital Infection Control Practitioners and/or the Chairpersons of
22	Hospital Infection Control Committees;
23	Directors of laboratories doing business in the State of Arkansas;
24	Medical Directors of In-Home Health agencies;
25	Program Directors of State agencies to whom an HIV/AIDS diagnosis has
26	been disclosed;
27	Nursing Home Medical Directors; and
28	those other persons as are required by the rules and regulations of the
29	Arkansas Department of Health.
30	
31	SECTION 2. Privileged Communications.
32	Notwithstanding the provisions of this act or any other law, the
33	privileged communications provisions codified as A.C.A. §§17-39-107 et seq.
34	are not repealed and no insurer or hospital and medical service corporation
35	may deny payment of benefits for services rendered by those licensed pursuant
36	to A.C.A. §§17-39-301 et seq. for covered services.

         SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

 4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
 5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.
