For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-3-102(9) TO ESTABLISH
9 AGE FIFTY-TWO (52) AS THE MINIMUM RETIREMENT AGE FOR A
10 DEPUTY SHERIFF WITH TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS OF SERVICE; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-3-102(9) is amended to add an additional
16 subdivision to read as follows:

17 "(E) Notwithstanding subdivision (C), in the case of a deputy sheriff
18 who has a minimum of twenty-five (25) years of actual service as a deputy
19 sheriff, the minimum retirement age shall be fifty-two (52) years;"

21 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
22 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
23 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

24

25 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
26 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
27 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
28 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
29 act are declared to be severable.

30

31 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
32 hereby repealed.
