Arkansas Code 10-3-218 is hereby amended to read as follows: 20 21 "10-3-218. Budget Hearings - Attendance by members of the General 22 Assembly. (a) During the presession budget hearings conducted by the Legislative 23 24 Council and the Joint Budget Committee preceding each regular biennial 25 session, the chairman of the Legislative Council shall cause copies of the 26 budget hearing agendas to be furnished to each member of the General Assembly, 27 in order that all members of the Senate and House of Representatives will be 28 advised of the times when such hearings are conducted and of the budget 29 requests to be heard or considered each day of the hearings. 3 0 (b) All members of the Senate and House of Representatives who will be 31 serving in the upcoming regular biennial session of the General Assembly, 32 including the newly elected members of the Senate and House of 33 Representatives, shall be entitled to attend any or all biennial presession 34 budget hearings conducted by the Legislative Council and the Joint Budget 35 Committee and shall be entitled to receive per diem and mileage for attending

36 such meetings at the same rate as is provided for attendance at meetings of

1	joint interim committees of the General Assembly.

3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 10-3-802(b)(1) is hereby amended to read as
4	follows:
5	"(1) Five (5) members of the Senate to be named by the Senate Committee
6	on Committees. Each Senate member is authorized to appoint a member of the
7	Senate to serve as his or her alternate on the committee; and"
8	
9	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
10	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
11	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
12	
13	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
14	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
15	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
16	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
17	act are declared to be severable.
18	
19	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
20	hereby repealed.
