17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-316(b)(1) is amended to read as follows:
20	"(b)(1) The bodies of such deceased persons shall be returned to the
21	county from which they were brought by or at the expense of the State Crime
22	Laboratory only if the Chief Medical Examiner determines that the cause of
23	death was not suicide, accidental, or from natural causes. In cases where the
24	Chief Medical Examiner determines that the cause of death was suicide,
25	accidental, or from natural causes, the expense of transporting and returning
26	the bodies of such deceased persons shall be borne by whomever requests the
27	State Crime Laboratory to examine the cause of death, except for cases
28	referred under the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 12-12-315(a)(2). A body may
29	be transported when authorized by the prosecuting attorney, circuit court,
30	sheriff, or chief of police, or upon the request of the next of kin of the
31	deceased or the persons who may be responsible for burial, to a place other
32	than the county of origin."

34	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 1

2 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 6 act are declared to be severable. 7 8 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

9 hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General 11 12 Assembly that the return transportation of bodies for which postmortem 13 examination has been requested and completed is not the function of the State 14 Crime Laboratory, and that such responsibility places an undue hardship on the 15 resources available to the State Crime Laboratory and its personnel. 16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act being 17 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and 18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and 19 approval. 20 /s/ Senator Bell 21 22 APPROVED: 04/12/93 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32
