**ACT 1137 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 2140**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SEVENTY-NINTH SESSION PROJECTS  
9 ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND; TO DEFINE THE  
10 MONIES TO BE AVAILABLE IN SUCH ACCOUNT; AND TO DEFINE THE  
11 PURPOSES FOR WHICH MONIES MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE FROM THE  
12 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

14 "AN ACT ESTABLISH THE SEVENTY-NINTH SESSION PROJECTS  
15 ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND."  
16

17  
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19  
20 SECTION 1. There is hereby created and established on the books of the  
21 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Treasurer and the State Auditor,  
22 the "79th Session Projects Account" within the "General Improvement Fund",  
23 into which shall be transferred and credited the respective monies as  
24 hereinafter provided in this Act, to be used for providing financing, in the  
25 manner set forth herein, for the various projects and purposes enumerated in  
26 this Act to be financed from said account.

27 Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, or as soon thereafter  
28 as is practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer and credit to the "79th  
29 Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund", upon  
30 certification of the amounts thereof by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
31 the following:

32 (a) all unobligated and unallocated monies remaining in the "General  
33 Improvement Fund" which are not required to finance projects to be financed  
34 therefrom pursuant to appropriations enacted by the 78th General Assembly, or  
35 which have not been reappropriated or reallocated for financing from the  
36 "General Improvement Fund" by the 79th General Assembly.

1 (b) any unobligated or unallocated funds remaining in the "General  
2 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund" from monies accruing thereto during the 1991-  
3 93 fiscal biennium which are not required to finance enactments of the 79th  
4 General Assembly that do not expire on June 30, 1993.

5 (c) for the period commencing on July 1, 1993 and ending June 30,  
6 1995, the State Treasurer shall, after complying with provisions of (1)  
7 Arkansas Code 27-70-204 for distributing interest income earned from  
8 investment of average daily balances of the "State Highway and Transportation  
9 Department Fund"; (2) Arkansas Code 15-41-110 for distributing interest earned  
10 from investment of average daily balances of the "Game Protection Fund"; (3)  
11 the first two million dollars (\$2,000,000) of interest income received each  
12 fiscal year by the State Treasurer as authorized in Arkansas Code 15-5-422;  
13 and (4) the next one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) of interest income  
14 received each fiscal year by the State Treasurer as authorized in Arkansas  
15 Code 20-78-504; credit to the "Budget Stabilization Trust Fund" or its  
16 successor fund, fifty percent (50%) of the interest income received and  
17 credited to the "Securities Reserve Fund", and credit to the "79th Session  
18 Projects Account" fifty percent (50%) of the interest income received and  
19 credited to the "Securities Reserve Fund" as certified by the Chief Fiscal  
20 Officer of the State, that is required to provide financing to the "79th  
21 Session Projects Account," until there has been credited an amount required,  
22 which when added to the other funds available for such purposes will finance  
23 each of the projects or purposes hereinafter enumerated.

25 SECTION 2. (A) From the monies accruing to the benefit of the "79th  
26 Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund" as authorized by  
27 Section 1 of this Act, the Governor may direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
28 State to effectuate an allocation of monies for financing certain  
29 appropriation and transfers of monies as authorized by the 79th General  
30 Assembly as follows:

29 In the event all of the allocations of monies for any of the purposes or  
30 projects listed above cannot be made due to the inadequacy of required  
31 matching monies, the Governor is hereby authorized to defer to a later time,  
32 such allocations and then proceed to authorize allocations of monies in  
33 accordance with the provisions of paragraph (B) of this Section. Such  
34 allocations of monies previously deferred, may be authorized by the Governor  
35 at any time after complying with the matching requirements.



1 (B) After financing is provided for the purposes and projects  
2 enumerated in Subsection (A) herein; from the remaining monies accruing to the  
3 benefit of the "79th Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement  
4 Fund" as authorized by Section 1 of this Act, the Governor may direct the  
5 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to effectuate an allocation of monies for

(C) After financing is provided for the purposes and projects enumerated in Subsections (A) and (B) herein; from the remaining monies accruing to the benefit of the "79th Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund" as authorized in Section 1 of this Act, the Governor may direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to effectuate an allocation of monies for the following purposes:

5 SECTION 3. (A) In the event monies are not available or are estimated  
6 not to become available to fully finance all of the projects for which  
7 allocations are provided in Subsection (A) of Section 2 of this Act, the

15 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
16 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
17 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

19 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
20 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
21 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
22 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
23 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

24

25 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
26 with this Act are hereby repealed.

27

28 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined that  
29 the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session has considered  
30 and enacted appropriations for construction projects, and other programs to be  
31 financed from the accumulated surplus and reserve funds available in the State  
32 Treasury and that the immediate passage of this Act is necessary to establish  
33 a method of providing for the orderly financing and a system of priority for  
34 the financing of such projects. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to  
35 exist, and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the

1 public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and  
2 after its passage and approval.
