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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:			
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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-27-346 is hereby amended to read as			
23	follows:			
24	"9-27-346. Support orders.			
25	(a) If it appears at the adjudication or disposition hearing in any			
26	case brought under this subchapter that the parents or any other person named			
27	in the petition who are by law required to provide support for the juvenile			
28	are able to contribute to the support of the juvenile the court shall refer			
29	the question of child support to the Child Support Enforcement Unit and upon			
30	petition by the Unit shall issue an order requiring such person to pay a			
31	reasonable sum for the support, maintenance, or education of the juvenile to			
32	any person, agency, or institution to whom custody is awarded.			
33	(b) The court shall, from time to time, on application from the Child			
34	Support Enforcement Unit, make such adjustments and modifications of the order			
35	as may appear reasonable and proper.			
36	(c) The court shall also order such persons required by law to support			

1 a juvenile to disclose their place of employment and the amount earned by 2 them. Anyone who refuses to disclose such information may be cited for 3 contempt of the juvenile court." 5 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 9-14-224 is amended to read as follows: "9-14-224. Income withholding - Duties of payor. (a) A payor who has been notified of an order of income withholding 8 shall be bound by the order until further notice by the court or its 9 representative. (b) A payor who is an employer that withholds support payments from 10 11 more than one employee shall have the option to periodically remit to the 12 clerk funds withheld from all such employees in a single check rather than 13 remitting the funds withheld from each employee separately. If the payor 14 elects to remit all such funds in a single check, each such remittance shall 15 be accompanied by a list showing the portion of the funds withheld from each 16 employee. 17 A payor shall notify the court or its representative immediately 18 when the noncustodial parent terminates employment or takes other adverse 19 action terminating the income source and shall provide the noncustodial 20 parent's last known address and the name and address of any new employer, if 21 known." 22 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 23 24 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 25 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 26 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 2.7 28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 29 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 30 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 31 act are declared to be severable. 32 33 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
