15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
16	
17	SECTION 1. (a) There is created the Arkansas Task Force on Timber Land
18	Assessment. The Task Force shall be composed of five (5) members. The
19	Speaker of the House shall appoint one (1) member of the House of the
20	Representatives as a member of the task force. The President Pro Tempore of
21	the Senate shall appoint one (1) member of the Senate as a member of the task
22	force. The Governor shall appoint three (3) members to be selected as
23	follows: one (1) County Assessor, one (1) representative of the timber
24	industry, and one (1) superintendent of a public school.
25	(b) The task force shall examine the use valuation, for tax purposes,
26	of timber land that has additional uses. The task force shall make a report
27	of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the Arkansas General
28	Assembly.
29	(c) The Assessment Coordination division shall provide staff support
30	for the task force.
31	(d) The members of the task force shall serve without compensation for
32	their services.
33	
34	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 6 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
