SENATE BILL 432

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED 6-5-305 TO ALLOW
9 EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE TRUST FUNDS TO BE SUBJECTED TO THE
10 EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS FOR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION BUT NOT
11 FOR WEIGHTED INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS WITH
12 DISABILITIES AND GIFTED STUDENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO ALLOW EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE TRUST FUNDS TO BE
16 SUBJECTED TO EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS FOR VOCATIONAL
17 EDUCATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated 6-5-305 is amended to read as
22 follows:

23 "6-5-305. Exemption from expenditure requirements.

24 Educational Trust Fund moneys established under this subchapter shall
25 not be subject to expenditure requirements for weighted instructional programs
26 for students with disabilities and gifted and talented students as described
27 in Arkansas Code Annotated 6-20-302 (2)(A) and (2)(E), 6-20-316 and 6-20-317.
28 *Educational Trust Funds necessary to fund the additional costs in those*
29 *districts that send students to the area vocational centers shall be withheld*
30 *by the Department of Education and remitted to the respective area vocational*
31 *centers."*

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
34 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
35 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5 act are declared to be severable.

7 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8 hereby repealed.
