# A Bill

**ACT 176 OF 1993**  
**SENATE BILL 252**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-89-101(a) TO CLARIFY  
OPTOMETRISTS\_ USE OF PRESCRIPTION ORAL DRUGS; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

**"TO CLARIFY OPTOMETRISTS\_ USE OF PRESCRIPTION  
ORAL DRUGS."**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-89-101(a) is hereby amended to read as follows:**

**"(a) The \_practice of optometry\_ means the examination, diagnosis, and treatment of conditions of the human eye, lid, adnexa, and visual system, including the removal of superficial foreign bodies from the cornea, conjunctiva, lid, or adnexa, but shall exclude other surgery of the lid, adnexa, or visual system. Optometry shall include utilizing any method or means which the licensed optometrist is educationally qualified to provide, as established and determined by the Arkansas State Board of Optometry. In administering this chapter, the Arkansas State Board of Optometry shall by rule or regulation prescribe those acts, services, procedures, and practices which constitute the practice of optometry. The practice of optometry does not include laser surgery or the administration of any drug by injection, the use of prescription oral drugs the use of controlled drugs, and the sale of prescription drugs, with the exception of contact lenses."**

**SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.**

**SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of**

1 **the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end**  
2 **the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.**

4 **SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.**
