 SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding any and all laws regarding county planning and zoning, all counties in Arkansas are authorized to establish, by ordinance, zones to limit or to regulate the construction or operation, or both, of *commercial* medical waste incinerators within their boundaries.

- (b) The *commercial* medical waste incinerator zoning ordinance shall be enforced through the issuance or denial of building and use permits in accordance with the conditions and terms of the limitations and regulations established by the ordinance.
- (c) When the county quorum court shall have laid off zones, by ordinance, to limit or to regulate the construction or operation, or both, of *commercial* medical waste incinerators, it shall be unlawful for anyone to construct or to operate a *commercial* medical waste incinerator within a given zone except in accordance with any building and use permits issued for the incinerator.
- (d) Violations of any provision of an ordinance adopted as authorized by this act shall be considered a misdemeanor. Each day's violation shall be considered a separate offense. The county adopting the ordinance or any individual aggrieved by a violation of the ordinance may request injunction against any *commercial* medical waste incinerator or property owner who is in violation of the ordinance.

SECTION 3. "Commercial medical waste" means any medical waste transported from a generator to an off-site facility for disposal and such off-site disposal facility is engaged in medical waste disposal for profit.

SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 5. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

1	SECTION 7. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth
2	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the powers of local governments in Arkansas to
3	${\bf regulate\ the\ construction\ or\ operation\ of\ } {\it commercial\ } {\bf medical\ waste\ incinerators\ are\ vague\ or\ }$
4	incomplete; that the un-regulated incineration of <i>commercial</i> medical waste poses a threat to
5	the health and safety of the citizens of Arkansas cities and counties; and therefore <i>commercial</i>
6	medical waste incinerators should be made subject to the regulation by and control of local
7	governments in Arkansas. Therefore, in order to clearly establish the authority of local
8	governments to limit and regulate <i>commercial</i> medical waste incinerators, an emergency is
9	hereby declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
10	public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
11	approval.
