# **A Bill**

**ACT 240 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 1325**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 16-21-801(d) TO INCREASE  
9 THE SALARY AND EXPENSES OF THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY  
10 FOR RANDOLPH COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### **Subtitle**

13 **"TO INCREASE THE SALARY AND EXPENSES OF THE**  
14 **DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY FOR RANDOLPH**  
15 **COUNTY."**

17 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

19 **SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-21-801(d) is amended to read as follows:**

20 **"(d) The annual salary for the deputy prosecuting attorney for Randolph County shall be a**  
21 **minimum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500) and a maximum of twenty**  
22 **thousand dollars (\$20,000), to be paid by the county. The Randolph County deputy**  
23 **prosecuting attorney shall receive an annual expense allowance of a minimum of six thousand**  
24 **dollars (\$6,000) and a maximum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), to be paid by the county.**  
25 **The salary and expenses provided in this subsection shall apply retroactively to January 1,**  
26 **1993."**

28 **SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are**  
29 **amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision**  
30 **Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.**

32 **SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or**  
33 **circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of**  
34 **the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end**  
35 **the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.**

1           **SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.**

3           **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General**  
4 **Assembly that the present law establishing the salary of deputy prosecuting attorney for**  
5 **Randolph County is inadequate; that this act will give Randolph County more flexibility in**  
6 **setting the salary for its deputy prosecuting attorney; and that until this act goes into effect the**  
7 **county will not have the necessary flexibility for establishing an adequate salary for the deputy**  
8 **prosecuting attorney. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being**  
9 **necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full**  
10 **force and effect from and after its passage and approval.**
