ACT 304 OF 1993
HOUSE BILL 1446

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
9 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR
10 CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING THE RADIATION THERAPY INSTITUTE
11 IN MOUNTAIN HOME; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 **"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND**
15 **ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER CAPITAL**
16 **IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION."**

18 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

20 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to the Department
21 of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General
22 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

23 **(A) For constructing and equipping the Radiation Therapy Institute in Mountain**
24 **Home, Arkansas, the sum of.....\$650,000.**

26 **SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded**
27 **nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in**
28 **excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided,**
29 **however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use**
30 **grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds,**
31 **or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing**
32 **the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the**
33 **appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and**
34 **General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be**
35 **used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.**

1 **(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the**
2 **General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any**
3 **other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the**
4 **Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied**
5 **with in disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically provided otherwise**
6 **by law.**

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8 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that**
9 **any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in**
10 **compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency**
11 **Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the**
12 **budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or**
13 **summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint**
14 **Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.**

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16 **SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are**
17 **amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision**
18 **Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.**

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20 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof**
21 **to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions**
22 **or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,**
23 **and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.**

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25 **SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with**
26 **this Act are hereby repealed.**

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28 **SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the**
29 **Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the**
30 **appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on**
31 **July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act**
32 **are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the**
33 **effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the proper**
34 **administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is**
35 **hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the**

1 **public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.**
