Arkansas Code 15-6-106(a)(10) is amended to read as follows: 2.8 "(10) To promote and encourage the establishment of a nonprofit 29 30 foundation, a Center for Rural Arkansas, and to cooperate and coordinate with 31 and assist the Center in accessing state and federal government and private 32 nonprofit and corporate foundation grant funds to aid in rural development and 33 revitalization for rural Arkansas." 34 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 35 36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
