# A Bill

ACT 660 OF 1993  
SENATE BILL 554

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE TRANSFER OF CHILDREN BETWEEN  
9 CUSTODIAL AND NON-CUSTODIAL PARENTS FROM OCCURRING ON  
10 PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "TO PROHIBIT THE TRANSFER OF CHILDREN BETWEEN CUSTODIAL  
14 AND NON-CUSTODIAL PARENTS ON PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. (a) In order to avoid continuing child custody  
19 controversies from involving public school personnel, and to avoid disruptions  
20 to the educational atmosphere in our public schools, the transfer of a child  
21 between the child\_s custodial parent and non-custodial parent, when both  
22 parents are present, is prohibited from taking place on the real property of a  
23 public elementary or secondary school on normal school days during normal  
24 hours of school operations.

25 (b) The provisions of this act shall not prohibit one parent (custodial  
26 or non-custodial) from transporting the child to school and the other parent  
27 (custodial or non-custodial) from picking the child up from school at pre-  
28 arranged times on pre-arranged days if prior approval has been made with the  
29 school\_s principal.

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
6 hereby repealed.
