# A Bill

**ACT 664 OF 1993**  
**SENATE BILL 569**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE GATEWAY TECHNICAL COLLEGE FOR  
10 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE GATEWAY TECHNICAL COLLEGE APPROPRIATION."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
19 Gateway Technical College for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum  
20 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
21 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
22 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
23 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
24 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
25 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
26 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
27 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
28 successor.

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15 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Gateway

16 Technical College for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of

17 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from

18 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: thirteen (13) temporary or

19 part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided

20 in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this

21 act for the appropriate classification.

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23 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the

24 Gateway Technical College, to be payable from the Gateway Technical College

25 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Gateway Technical

26 College for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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9 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,

10 to the Gateway Technical College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by

11 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Gateway Technical College, for personal services

12 and operating expenses of the Gateway Technical College for the biennial

13 period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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34 SECTION 5. PRIORITIES. A high priority of the Gateway Technical

35 College shall be the combatting of illiteracy and the providing of industrial

1 training, in the work place.

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3 SECTION 6. The appropriation level provided in Section 3 of this Act  
4 shall not be construed as a commitment of the Arkansas General Assembly to  
5 provide a particular level of support from the Work Force 2000 Development  
6 Fund for the Gateway Technical College but rather that the funds to be made  
7 available are to be based upon legitimate criteria and accreditation  
8 requirements as determined by the State Board of Higher Education for all  
9 technical colleges.

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11 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
12 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
14 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions  
17 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where  
18 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
19 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
20 disbursement of said funds.

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22 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
24 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
25 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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31 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
32 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
33 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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35 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

1 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
2 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
3 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
4 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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6 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
7 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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9 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
10 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
11 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
12 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
14 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
15 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
16 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
17 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
18 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
19 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
