# A Bill

**ACT 667 OF 1993**  
**SENATE BILL 584**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE EAST ARKANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE EAST ARKANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the East  
20 Arkansas Community College for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum  
21 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
22 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
23 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
24 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
25 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
26 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
27 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
28 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
29 successor.

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13 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the East  
14 Arkansas Community College for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum  
15 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
16 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Two hundred twenty  
17 four (224) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not  
18 to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act,  
19 or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL REVENUE. There is hereby  
22 appropriated, to the East Arkansas Community College, to be payable from the  
23 East Arkansas Community College Fund, for personal services and operating  
24 expenses of the East Arkansas Community College for the biennial period ending  
25 ~~June 30, 1995, the following:~~

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5 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 6 to the East Arkansas Community College, to be payable from cash funds as  
 7 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the East Arkansas Community College, for  
 8 ~~personal services and operating expenses of the East Arkansas Community~~  
 9 College for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

29 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 30 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 31 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 32 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions  
 35 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where

1 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
2 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
3 disbursement of said funds.

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5 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
6 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
7 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
8 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
9 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
10 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
11 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
12 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

14 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
15 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
16 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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18 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
19 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
20 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
21 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
22 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

24 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
25 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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27 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
28 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
29 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
30 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
32 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

1 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
