# A Bill

**ACT 723 OF 1993**  
**SENATE BILL 81**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-67-203 TO IDENTIFY  
ADDITIONAL SCENIC HIGHWAYS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-67-203 TO IDENTIFY  
ADDITIONAL SCENIC HIGHWAYS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Arkansas Code 27-67-203 is amended to read  
as follows:

"(a) The following highways and designated parts of highways within the  
State of Arkansas are designated as scenic highways:

- (1) U.S. 65 from Louisiana line to Missouri line;
- (2) U.S. 71 from Louisiana line to Missouri line;
- (3) U.S. 82 from Mississippi River to Texarkana;
- (4) U.S. 270 from U.S. 71 to Hot Springs;
- (5) I-30 from Little Rock to U.S. 70 west of Benton and U.S. 70 to Hot  
Springs;
- (6) I-40 from Little Rock to Oklahoma line west of Fort Smith;
- (7) U.S. 63 from I-55 at Turrell to Mammoth Spring;
- (8) U.S. 62 from Missouri line to Oklahoma line;
- (9) State 7 from Louisiana line to Bull Shoals Lake north of Harrison;
- (10) Great River Road State 54 and State 1 from Dumas to Crossroads.  
Route on new location to Wabash, then State 44 through St. Francis National  
Forest to Marianna. U.S. 79 and State 38 and State 147 past Horseshoe Lake  
back to U.S. 79 and U.S. 70 to West Memphis. U.S. 70 through West Memphis to  
I-55 and to the Tennessee State Line. From the beginning of State 77 and U.S.  
70 in West Memphis to the Missouri State Line;

- 1 (11) State 32 and State 355 from Ashdown to Mineral Springs;
- 2 (12) State 27 to Kirby. U.S. 70 and State 8 to Norman. State 27 to
- 3 Dardanelle. State 27 from Dover to Harriet;
- 4 (13) State 9 from Crows to Jct. U.S. 65. State 16 from U.S. 65 to
- 5 Shirley. State 9 from Shirley to Mammoth Spring;
- 6 (14) State 28 from U.S. 71 to Ola;
- 7 (15) State 154 from Oppelo to State 27;
- 8 (16) State 23 from U.S. 71 to Missouri line;
- 9 (17) State 309 from State 10 to State 23 at Ozark;
- 10 (18) State 21 from Clarksville to Missouri line;
- 11 (19) State 16 from Searcy to Siloam Springs, including connecting
- 12 segment of State 25 at Heber Springs;
- 13 (20) State 14 from U.S. 63 to Table Rock Lake;
- 14 (21) State 68 from Alpena to Siloam Springs;
- 15 (22) State 5 from U.S. 67 to Missouri line;
- 16 (23) *State 25 from its intersection with U.S. 65 to Heber Springs,*
- 17 *State 25 from Heber Springs to Batesville, U.S. 167 from Batesville to Ash*
- 18 *Flat, State 286 from its intersection with I-40 to its intersection with State*
- 19 *60, State 60 from its intersection with State 286 to Perryville, and State 10*
- 20 *from its intersection with State 9 to I-430;*
- 21 (24) State 58 from Sage through Guion, and State 69 to Melbourne;
- 22 (25) State 178 from Flippin to Mountain Home;
- 23 (26) State 88 from Oklahoma line to Mena;
- 24 (27) State 59 from Van Buren to Jct. State 220;
- 25 (28) State 220 from Jct. 59 to State 74 at Devil's Den State Park;
- 26 (29) State 170 from Devil's Den State Park to U.S. 71 at West Fork;
- 27 (30) *I-40 from Tennessee State Line to Little Rock;*
- 28 (31) I-30 from Benton south to the Clark County line;
- 29 (32) State 10 from Ola to Greenwood;
- 30 (33) State 22 from Dardanelle to Paris;
- 31 (34) State 12 from Rogers to Jct. State 23.
- 32 (35) State Highway 141 from Jonesboro to McDougal;
- 33 (36) State Highway 125 from its intersection with Highway 14 north of
- 34 Yellville to the Missouri line.
- 35 (37) U.S. Highway 49 from its intersection at Brinkley to the

1 Mississippi state line will be known as the \_Delta Parkway, an Arkansas Scenic  
2 Highway\_.

3 (38) Highway 5 from Benton to Hot Springs."

5 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
13 act are declared to be severable.

15 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
16 hereby repealed.
