# A Bill

**ACT 777 OF 1993**  
**SENATE BILL 469**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 5-4-322 TO AUTHORIZE  
9 MUNICIPAL COURTS TO REQUIRE OFFENDERS SENTENCED TO PUBLIC  
10 SERVICE WORK TO PAY A SUPERVISORY FEE; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE MUNICIPAL COURTS TO ORDER OFFENDERS  
15 TO PAY A PUBLIC SERVICE WORK SUPERVISORY FEE."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-4-322 is hereby amended to read as  
20 follows:

21 "5-4-322. Fine and probation fee or public service work fee authorized.

22 (a) A municipal court may place a person on probation or sentence them  
23 to public service work, and may, as a condition of its order, require the  
24 defendant to pay a fine in one (1) or several sums, and in addition may  
25 require the person to pay a probation fee or pay a public service work  
26 supervisory fee in an amount to be established by the municipal court. This  
27 section shall not apply in instances where the defendant is charged with  
28 violating the Omnibus DWI Act, § 5-65-101 et seq.

29 (b) This section is supplemental to all other laws allowing a municipal  
30 court to attach conditions on an order of probation."

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.
