8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED 16-13-510(a) TO
9 CONDITION A COURT REPORTER_S DUTY TO TRANSCRIBE A COURT
10 RECORD UPON THE PAYMENT OF A PERCENTAGE OF THE COST; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §16-13-510(a) is amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "§16-13-510. Complete record required - Waiver.

23 (a) In all cases before the circuit, chancery or probate courts of this
24 state, a complete record of the proceedings shall be made by the official
25 court reporter, or other reporter designated by the court. Upon the request
26 of either party or the circuit, chancery or probate judge, said record shall
27 be transcribed, certified by the reporter as true and correct, and filed with
28 the clerk of the court in which the proceedings were had, not less than ten
29 (10) days before the expiration of time allowed for appeal. The court
30 reporter_s duty to transcribe and certify the record may be conditioned upon
31 the payment, when requested by the court reporter, of *up to fifty percent*
32 (50%) of the estimated cost of the transcript."

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
