1 SECTION 29. It is the intent of the General Assembly that when any
2 state agency, board, commission or institution of higher education admits
3 liability to a claim filed with the State Claims Commission *and the claim*
4 *involves a contract with state agency, board, commission or institution of*
5 *higher education or the claim exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000)* that such
6 agency, board, commission or institution of higher education file a written
7 report thereof to the Litigation Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative
8 Council. Such report shall include a concise statement of facts with an
9 explanation of the agency's liability. Provided further, such report shall be
10 filed with the Litigation Subcommittee within thirty (30) days after the claim
11 has been adjudicated by the State Claims Commission. No state employee shall
12 serve both in a full-time quasi judicial position, or in a full-time position
13 which provides legal assistance to a quasi judicial position, in the State
14 Claims Commission, Arkansas Public Service Commission, Workers Compensation
15 Commission, State Department for Social Security Disability Determination or
16 any other quasi judicial agency, department or commission and also serve as an
17 elected judge. *For purposes of this act the term "state employee" shall mean*
18 *anyone who works one thousand (1,000) hours or more per year and participates*
19 *in the public employees retirement system.*

20

21 SECTION 30. Any state agency which is affected by the allowed claim(s)
22 provided for in this Act, and whose funds for the 1992-93 fiscal year are
23 insufficient to allow for the payment of said claim(s) before June 30, 1993,
24 is hereby authorized, upon certification by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
25 State, to make payment of said claim(s) after July 1, 1993, from funds
26 appropriated for the 1993-94 fiscal year.

27

28 SECTION 31. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission is hereby made the
29 disbursing officer for the purpose of paying the claims appropriated by this
30 Act. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission is hereby authorized to receive
31 all warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act from the Auditor of
32 State and to distribute same to the claimants.

33

34 SECTION 32. In the event that any claim authorized herein is determined
35 to be a valid claim against the State and the claim is to be paid from funds

1 not in the State Treasury, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall
2 notify the agency against which the claim is to be charged of the amount of
3 such claims. Upon receipt of such notification, the state agency shall
4 forth-with deliver a check to the Clerk of the State Claims Commission who
5 shall deposit the same as a nonrevenue receipt into the Miscellaneous
6 Revolving Fund from which he shall disburse the amount of the claim to the
7 claimant.

8

9 SECTION 33. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
15 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
16 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

18

19 SECTION 34. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
22 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27

28 SECTION 35. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
29 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
30 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31

32 SECTION 36. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
33 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
34 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
35 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

1 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

2

3 SECTION 37. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
4 with this Act are hereby repealed.

5

6 SECTION 38. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
7 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that payees listed in this Act may be entitled
8 to the sums appropriated and transferred to herein, and that they have been
9 deprived of the use of these funds for a long period of time, and that further
10 delay in paying these just debts of the State would do harm to the reputation
11 of the State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
12 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
13 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its
14 passage and approval.
