# A Bill

**ACT 16 OF 1995**  
**HOUSE BILL 1058**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE BOARD OF DISPENSING  
10 OPTICIANS FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997;  
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE STATE BOARD OF  
15 DISPENSING OPTICIANS APPROPRIATION FOR  
16 THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
21 Board of Dispensing Opticians for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum  
22 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
23 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
24 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
25 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
26 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
27 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
28 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
29 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
30 successor.

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3 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State  
 4 Board of Dispensing Opticians for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum  
 5 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
 6 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary  
 7 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those  
 8 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor,  
 9 or this act for the appropriate classification.

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11 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State  
 12 Board of Dispensing Opticians, to be payable from the Board of Dispensing  
 13 Opticians' Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the State  
 14 Board of Dispensing Opticians for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997,  
 15 the following:

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32 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 33 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 35 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
3 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
4 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7       SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
10 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16       SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20       SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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26       SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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29       SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
30 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
31 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
32 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of  
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
34 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
35 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the

1 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
2 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
3 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
4 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
