HOUSE BILL 1420

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING EXPENSES
9 FOR THE ARKANSAS APPRAISER LICENSING AND CERTIFICATION
10 BOARD WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE
11 FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 91 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

15 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS APPRAISER
16 LICENSING AND CERTIFICATION BOARD
17 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board, to be payable from cash
23 funds as defined by Arkansas Code §19-4-801 of the Arkansas Appraiser
24 Licensing and Certification Board, for operating expenses of the Arkansas
25 Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board which shall be supplemental and in
26 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 2 of Act 91 of 1993, the
27 following:

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6 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

7 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

8 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

9 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control

12 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the

13 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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16 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

18 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which

19 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent

26 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

27 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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29 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

30 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

31 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

32 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

33 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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35 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict

1 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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3 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
4 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the
5 operations of the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board are,
6 due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Appraiser
7 Licensing and Certification Board to continue to provide essential
8 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the
9 necessary monies for the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board
10 to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act
11 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
12 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
13 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
14 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
15 after the date of its passage and approval.
