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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Post
22 Prison Transfer Board, the following maximum number of regular employees which
23 shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Section
24 1 of Act 958 of 1993 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of
25 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
26 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
27 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
28 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
29 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
30 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
31 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Post
6 Prison Transfer Board, to be payable from the State General Services Fund
7 Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Post Prison
8 Transfer Board which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
9 appropriated in Section 2 of Act 958 of 1993, for the remainder of the biennial
10 period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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25 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
26 by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
28 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
29 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
30 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
31 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
32 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
33 with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in
2 this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was
3 adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and
4 Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the
5 Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony
6 in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
7 Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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9 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
10 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
11 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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13 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
14 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
15 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
16 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
17 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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19 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
20 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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22 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
23 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the
24 operations of the Post Prison Transfer Board are, due to unforeseen
25 circumstances, insufficient for the Post Prison Transfer Board to continue to
26 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will
27 provide the necessary monies for the Post Prison Transfer Board to continue
28 such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
29 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
30 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
31 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
32 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of
33 its passage and approval.
