15	"ESTABLISH GREATER SAFETY ON OUR
16	HIGHWAYS AND ENHANCE LONGEVITY OF BOTH

18	STREETS AND HIGHWAYS LOCATED WITHIN THE
19	STATE OF ARKANSAS.

21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22	
23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-35-108 is amended to read as follows:
24	"§ 27-35-108. Authority to weigh vehicles and require removal of excess
25	loads.
26	(a)(1) Any police officer having reason to believe that the weight of a
27	vehicle and load is unlawful is authorized to require the driver to stop and
28	submit to a weighing, either by means of portable or stationary scales, and
29	may require that the vehicle be driven to the nearest public scales in the
30	event the scales are within two (2) miles.
31	(2) The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to
32	vehicles owned and operated by the State of Arkansas or any city or county of
33	this state.
34	(b)(1) Whenever an officer, upon weighing a vehicle and load as
35	provided in subsection (a) of this section, determines that the weight is
36	unlawful, the officer may require the driver to stop the vehicle in a suitable

1 place and remain standing until such portion of the load is removed as may be 2 necessary to reduce the gross weight of the vehicle to the limit permitted 3 under this chapter. (2) All material so unloaded shall be cared for by the owner or 5 operator of the vehicle at the risk of the owner or operator. (c) Any driver of a vehicle who fails or refuses to stop and submit the 7 vehicle and load to a weighing, or who fails or refuses when directed by an 8 officer upon a weighing of the vehicle to stop the vehicle and otherwise 9 comply with the provisions of this section, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. (d) It shall also be the duty of county sheriffs or any other state or 11 local police officers to enforce, or to cooperate in enforcing, the weight 12 limits specified in this chapter or authorized on any public way in this state 13 and to prevent overloading of vehicles or other violations of the traffic laws 14 upon the public highways within their respective jurisdictions." 15 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 17 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 18 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 19 20 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 24 act are declared to be severable. 2.5 26 SECTION 4.
