HOUSE BILL 1614

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL CASE COORDINATOR FOR
9 THE NINTH CIRCUIT-CHANCERY COURT CIRCUIT WEST; TO
10 ESTABLISH A SALARY RANGE FOR THE ADDITIONAL CASE
11 COORDINATOR AND TO PRESCRIBE THE METHOD OF PAYMENT OF SUCH
12 SALARY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL CASE
16 COORDINATOR FOR THE 9TH CIRCUIT-CHANCERY
17 COURT CIRCUIT WEST; ESTABLISH A SALARY
18 RANGE; AND PRESCRIBE METHOD OF PAYMENT."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. The person selected to fill the additional circuit-chancery
23 judge position created in the Ninth Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit West by the
24 Eightieth General Assembly shall be entitled to employ a case coordinator
25 whose primary responsibility shall be to maintain the court calendar, schedule
26 dates for the trial of cases and for the hearing of motions and to perform
27 other related and incidental duties at the direction of the judge.

28
29 SECTION 2. The case coordinator provided for in Section 1 shall receive
30 an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more
31 than twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000). The salary and expenses of the
32 case coordinator shall be paid by the counties comprising the Ninth Circuit-
33 Chancery Court Circuit West, with the proportion thereof to be paid by each
34 county to be determined by the judge after giving consideration to the
35 assessed value of property in each county, the population of each county and
36 the case load of the court in each county. The salary provided for herein

1 shall be paid by each county in equal monthly installments on the first day of
2 each month.

4 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7

8 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 act are declared to be severable.

13

14 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
15 hereby repealed.

16

17 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
18 Assembly that the Eightieth General Assembly created an additional circuit-
19 chancery court judgeship in the Ninth Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit West;
20 that it is essential to the efficient and effective operation of the courts of
21 the district that the person selected to fill the additional judgeship be
22 authorized to employ a case coordinator to assist the judge in carrying out
23 his or her responsibilities; that this act is designed to authorize the
24 employment of such additional case coordinator and should be given effect
25 immediately. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act
26 being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety
27 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
