22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-6-207(c) is amended to add the following
25 language:

26 "(3) An unopposed candidate for an office described in subdivision
27 (a)(1) or any person acting in the unopposed candidate's behalf shall not be
28 required to file the ten (10) day preelection report required by subdivision
29 (a)(1)(C). "

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
34

35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 Act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
6 hereby repealed.
