20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Section 4(c) of Uncodified Act 868 of 1997 is amended to read
23 as follows:

24 "(c) The prosecuting attorney of the Eighteenth Judicial District -
25 West and those deputy prosecuting attorneys so designated shall be considered
26 law enforcement officers for the purpose of utilizing emergency, protective,
27 and communication equipment in the performance of their official duties and in
28 coordination with inter-agency cooperative investigations and operations,
29 specifically incorporating but not limited to the provisions of Arkansas Code
30 Annotated § 5-73-120(c)~~(1)~~(2). Provided that the prosecuting attorney and
31 such designated deputy prosecuting attorneys shall have no greater arrest
32 powers than that accorded all citizens under the Arkansas Constitution and the
33 Arkansas statutes."

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2
3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

8
9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.
