15 PROVIDE THAT COUNTIES MAY REIMBURSE

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-14-1207(c) is amended to read as follows:

24 "(c) Reimbursement of Travel Expense. (1) Privately Owned Motor
25 Vehicles. Any elected county or township officer, or employee thereof,
26 utilizing a privately owned motor vehicle in the conduct of county affairs may
27 be reimbursed at a per-mile rate established by ordinance. Reimbursement shall
28 be based only on official miles driven, and legitimate automobile parking
29 fees. ~~a~~A county shall not assume responsibility whatsoever for any
30 maintenance, operational cost, accidents, and ~~and~~ ~~fin~~es, ~~tolls,~~ ~~and~~ ~~parking fees~~
31 incurred by the owner of the vehicle while on official business for the
32 county. Where more than one (1) traveler is transported in the same vehicle,
33 only the owner shall be entitled to mileage reimbursement.

34 (2) Privately Owned Airplanes. Reimbursement for travel expense
35 utilizing privately owned airplanes shall be the same rate as established for
36 privately owned motor vehicles. However, reimbursement mileage shall be

1 determined by the shortest highway route to and from the official
2 destination."

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4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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8 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 act are declared to be severable.

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14 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
15 hereby repealed.
