17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-403(a)(1) is amended to read as follows:

20 "(a)(1) Applications for absentee ballots must be signed by the
21 applicant and verified by the county clerk by checking the voter's name,
22 address, date of birth and signature from the registration records or, if sent
23 by facsimile machine transmitted over telephone lines, must bear a verifiable
24 facsimile of the applicant's signature."
25

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
29

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.
35

36 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repeal ed.
