19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-13-1303 is amended to read as follows:

22 "16-13-1303. Judges and chancellors.

23 (a) The qualified electors of the Fifth Judicial District shall elect:

24 (1) One (1) circuit judge;

25 (2) One (1) chancellor; and

26 (3) One (1) circuit-chancery judge.

27 (b)(1) Each judge of the judgeship created by subdivision (a)(3) of
28 this section shall be the judge of the juvenile division of chancery court.
29 The judge shall serve as judge of the juvenile division in lieu of the judge
30 who would otherwise be designated as judge of the juvenile division of
31 chancery court in the judicial district.

32 (2) The judge of the additional circuit-chancery judgeship
33 created in subdivision (a)(3) of this section shall devote such time as may be
34 required to perform the duties of judge of the juvenile division, which duties
35 shall be the primary obligation of the judge, and shall sit as judge of the
36 circuit, chancery, or probate court as time permits.
