19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-13-616(c) is hereby repealed.

22 ~~(c)(1) A person whose residential property contains portions of two (2)~~  
23 ~~school districts shall be eligible to be a member of either of the school~~  
24 ~~districts' board of directors, provided he is a qualified elector of the~~  
25 ~~county in which the school district for which he seeks the position lies and~~  
26 ~~he has or formerly had children enrolled in that school district.~~

27 ~~(2) For purposes of this subsection, "residential property" means that~~  
28 ~~parcel of land which contains the dwelling in which the person resides no~~  
29 ~~fewer than nine (9) months out of each year.~~  
30

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
5 hereby repealed.
