24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-7-410(b)(1) is amended to read as follows:

27 "(b)(1) There is authorized to be deposited in the Emergency Response
28 Fund all moneys recovered pursuant to § 8-7-417, any moneys received by the
29 state as a gift or donation to the fund, all interest earned upon moneys
30 deposited in the fund, and all moneys received as penalties pursuant to the
31 Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, beginning at § 8-4-101 ~~et seq.~~,
32 the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act, as amended, beginning at § 8-7-
33 201 ~~et seq.~~, the Solid Waste Act, as amended, beginning at § 8-6-201 ~~et seq.~~,
34 ~~and~~ the Lead-Based Paint-Hazard Act, beginning at § 8-4-401 ~~et seq.~~, and the
35 Asbestos Material Act, beginning at § 20-27-1001."

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4
5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10
11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
