10 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 6-17-808 TO PROVIDE
11 CLASSIFIED PERSONNEL WITH IMPROVED AND BROADER SALARY
12 SCHEDULES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

14 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 6-17-808 TO
15 PROVIDE CLASSIFIED PERSONNEL WITH
16 IMPROVED AND BROADER SALARY SCHEDULES. "
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-17-808 is amended to read as follows:

23 "6-17-808. Arkansas Classified Personnel Salaries Study Commission.

24 (a) There is hereby created the Arkansas Classified Personnel Salaries
25 Study Commission to be composed of the following:

26 (1) ~~The~~ An appointee of the Chairman of the House Interim
27 Committee on Education ~~or his appointee~~;

28 (2) ~~The~~ An appointee of the Chairman of the Senate Interim
29 Committee on Education ~~or his appointee~~;

30 (3) The Director of General Education of the Department of
31 Education;

32 (4) The Director of Vocational and Technical Education of the
33 Department of Education;

34 (5) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Association of
35 Educational Administrators;

36 (6) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Education Association;

1 (7) One (1) representative of the Arkansas School Boards
2 Association; and

3 (8) The following persons to be appointed by the Governor:

4 (A) Five (5) public school classified personnel
5 representatives who shall include one (1) active employee from each of the
6 following job categories:

7 (i) School secretary or clerk;

8 (ii) School maintenance;

9 (iii) Bus driver;

10 (iv) Food service; and

11 (v) Aide or paraprofessional;

12 (B) One (1) public school superintendent; and

13 (C) Two (2) lay persons appointed from the state at large
14 who shall not be former school administrators.

15 (b)(1) The commission shall collect from Arkansas public schools the
16 salary schedules by job category for classified personnel and conduct a study
17 of the disparity and inadequacies in classified personnel salaries among the
18 state's school districts.

19 (2) The commission shall recommend solutions to the ~~1993~~ 2001
20 *General Assembly*, including minimum salary guarantees for classified personnel
21 salaries by specific job and classification.

22 (c) Technical support to the commission shall be provided by the State
23 Department of Education.

24 (d)(1) The school districts of this state shall adopt written salary
25 schedules for classified personnel annually and shall file such schedules with
26 the State Department of Education no later than ~~August 28~~ September 15 for the
27 school year in which they are in effect.

28 (2) Such schedules shall reflect the actual pay practices of the
29 district for classified personnel.

30 (e) As used herein, 'classified personnel' means all public school
31 personnel who are not required to hold a valid teaching certificate issued by
32 the Department of Education as a condition of employment and includes but need
33 not be limited to secretaries, maintenance employees, bus drivers, food
34 service employees, instructional aides, and paraprofessionals."

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36 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

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10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
