19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 3-4-216(c) and (d) are amended to read as
22 follows:

23 "(c) Alcoholic Beverage Control Division permits may be renewed late,
24 by paying the stated penalty, ~~between~~ beginning July 1 and ending October ~~29~~
25 28 of each fiscal year.

26 (d) No permit shall be renewed by the Alcoholic Beverage Control
27 Division for the current fiscal year after October ~~29~~ 28."

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 3-5-1205(1), pertaining to microbrewery-
30 restaurant licenses, is amended to read as follows:

31 "(1) Pay any applicable city or county license or permit fees and
32 barrelage or excise taxes and shall pay a state licensing fee to the ~~board~~
33 Alcoholic Beverage Control Division of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750) per
34 fiscal year to manufacture and sell its beer and malt beverages for
35 consumption both on and off the premises and to sell any other beer and malt
36 beverages purchased from a licensed wholesaler for consumption on the

1 premises; "

3 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 3-9-407(b) is amended to read as follows:

4 "(b) An annual renewal fee in the same amount as provided in subsection
5 (a) of this section shall be paid to the director on or before ~~July 1 of each~~
6 year June 30 of each calendar year for the fiscal year beginning July 1."

7
8 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

11
12 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16 act are declared to be severable.

17
18 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
19 hereby repealed.
