21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-6-704(a)(13), powers of regional solid waste
24 management board, is amended to read as follows:

25 "(13) To enter into agreements with ~~adjoining~~ another solid waste
26 management ~~districts~~ district to allow a district, or any person within that
27 district, to transfer solid waste into ~~an adjoining~~ another district;
28 provided, however, that notice of all such authorizations shall be submitted
29 to the department within thirty (30) days and shall be incorporated into the
30 district needs assessment in its next regular update; and"
31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

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6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.

8
9 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
10 Eighty-second General Assembly that the law concerning the transfer and
11 receipt of solid waste in the State of Arkansas is inadequate. This bill will
12 expand the ability of Regional Solid Waste Management Districts to seek the
13 effective disposal of solid waste. Providing these agreements will enhance
14 districts' ability to manage solid waste in a more cost-effective manner.
15 Immediate action on this bill is necessary to provide uninterrupted solid
16 waste disposal services throughout the state. Therefore, an emergency is
17 declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
18 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on
19 the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor
20 vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the
21 period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is
22 vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective
23 on the date the last house overrides the veto.
