20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 1-2-207 is amended to read as follows:

23 "1-2-207. Identical acts - Same subject matter.

24 (a) When identical acts are enacted by the General Assembly during the
25 same session, the act which the Governor signs last shall be deemed to have
26 repealed the earlier enactment. If the Governor does not sign one or both of
27 the acts then the act which was last voted on by either house of the General
28 Assembly shall be deemed to have repealed the other identical enactments.

29 (b) When more than one (1) act concerning the same subject matter is
30 enacted by the General Assembly during the same session, whether or not
31 specifically amending the same sections of the Arkansas Code or an uncodified
32 act, all of the enactments shall be given effect except to the extent of
33 irreconcilable conflicts in which case the conflicting provision of the last
34 enactment shall prevail. The last enactment is the one which the Governor
35 signed last or if the Governor does not sign one of the acts then the last
36 enactment is the act which was last voted on by either house of the General

1 Assembly ."

2
3 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

6
7 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.

13 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
14 hereby repealed.
