## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 8-6-609 AND 8-6-716 FOR  
11 THE PURPOSE OF STREAMLINING THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS  
12 FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARDS AND TO CLARIFY THE  
13 PROCEDURE TO REQUEST EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR SOLID  
14 WASTE REGIONAL NEEDS ASSESSMENT; AND FOR OTHER  
15 PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

17 "AN ACT TO AMEND PROCEDURES PERTAINING TO  
18 SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARDS. "

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-6-609(d)(2)(B) is amended to read as  
25 follows:

26 "~~(B) The report shall be filed six (6) months after disbursement of~~  
27 ~~funds and semi-annually for each year thereafter~~ The report shall be filed  
28 annually on or before April 1."  
29

30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 8-6-716(a)(1)(C)(ii) is amended to read as  
31 follows:

32 "(ii) The board may obtain an extension of that deadline from the  
33 ~~commission~~ director."  
34

35 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
7 act are declared to be severable.

9 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
10 hereby repealed.
