SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-second General Assembly that there is a pressing and immediate need for financial support in rural areas of Arkansas, that this act has as its purpose the furnishing of financial assistance to rural communities. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
