20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-14-811 is hereby amended to read as
23 follows:

24 "14-14-811. County judge's salary.

25 The quorum court of each county is authorized to pay a portion of the
26 salary and related matching benefits of the county judge from the county road
27 fund and the county solid waste fund. ~~However, the~~ The portion of the county
28 judge's salary paid from the county road fund shall not exceed fifty percent
29 (50%) and the portion paid from the county solid waste fund shall not exceed
30 thirty-four percent (34%). ~~However, the portion to be paid from the county~~
31 general fund shall be at least one-third (1/3) of the total salary and
32 matching benefits. "

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
